Caron Matter

On February 13, ACSTA legal counsel, Kevin Feehan appeared before the Supreme Court of Canada to represent ACSTA who was an intervener in the case to support French language and Catholic education rights in Alberta (and by extension Northwest Territories and Yukon). On average the Supreme Court takes up to six months to render a decision so we will not likely hear anything until summer.
