Video Contest Guidelines

1. Eligibility

The G.R.A.C.E. 3 Video Contest is open to all students, aged 12-19, who are currently attending a publicly funded Catholic school in Alberta, Northwest Territories and Yukon.

By submitting an entry, all entrants warrant and represent that they have full right and title to the entries so submitted and that such entries do not violate any prior copyright interests of any person, and further, each entrant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Alberta Catholic School Trustees' Association from any claim or action arising out of any breach of copyright caused by such entry.

All entries will be reviewed by the Alberta Catholic School Trustees' Association to ensure that the content of the entry is appropriate in nature and to ensure entries abide by the content restrictions contained in these official competition rules.

2. Submission Deadline

All contest entries must be received by April 21, 2017 at 4:30pm (MST).

3. Entry Requirements

Submission and Subject Matter

Submissions should consist of a message that communicates how the student's educational experience in Catholic schools has helped or inspired the student in their personal, academic and/or faith development. Students are encouraged to create videos that are fun and engaging!

4. Video Format

To make this contest as easy as possible to produce and share you are required to create a video that is no more than 2 minutes in length. The video must be uploaded to YouTube in order to be viewed by the judging committee. The distinctive URL created by YouTube for each uploaded video must be included on the Video Contest Submission form.

5. Parent Consent and Video Contest Submission Form

All entries must include a signed Parental/Guardian Video Contest Consent form.

6. Content Restrictions

Submitted videos must not contain:

- Inappropriate material as determined by the Alberta Catholic School Trustees' Association. This includes profanity.
 - Dangerous stunts.
- Material that is likely to cause offence to any person or to injure the name, reputation or standing of any person in any way, directly or indirectly.

7. Voting

After the submission deadline, the entries will be reviewed and winning entries will be determined by an ACSTA committee consisting of trustees and staff.
